As required by the program, all graduating students are to participate in the Kaplan Live Review session. The three day in person session, online course- *Roadmap to Success*, and practice test are mandatory for all students in order to be certified as having completed all graduation requirements and to sit for the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX) exam.

The review course will take place in 3 phases as listed below:

PHASE I-STUDY PLAN (completed before the in person review course starts):

- Watch the 5 videos under “Pathway to NCLEX® Success.”
- Watch the Phase One orientation video
- Take the Diagnostic Test
- Take Question Trainer 1-3
- Watch the Essential Nursing Content Videos
- Download the Classroom Posters

BON CERTIFICATION SCHEDULE

In order for students to receive an ATT date, the Office of the Academic Deans will run a report of the *NCLEX Practice Test* activity for all graduating students. This report in addition to the attendance sheets from the 3 day in person live review and *Roadmap to NCLEX Success* session will be used to determine eligibility for certification to the board of nursing. Students who complete all three phases of the Kaplan Live Review will be certified to the board no later than two weeks after graduation.
