All prerequisite courses must be completed before the start of the term you are applying for.

- You may have up to **four (4)** prerequisite courses in progress at time of application.
- Of those four, the following must already be completed:
 - At least **2 required science courses**: Chemistry, A&P I, A&P II, or Microbiology
 - At least **1 of the following**: Human Growth & Development, Statistics, or Nutrition
- You cannot have three science courses in progress at the same time.

Transcripts, Scores & Deadlines

Official transcripts	Required upon completion of any coursework in progress. Transcripts from all schools attended are mandatory — failure to submit disqualifies admission.
AP / CLEP scores	Required if used for prerequisite credit. See nursing.umaryland.edu/admissions/faq for Transfer of Credit by Examination FAQs.
Final submission deadline	All final transcripts and scores must be submitted one week prior to classes starting .
Proof of enrollment	Admitted students must submit by June 1 (fall) or Sept. 1 (spring) . Acceptable: official or unofficial transcript, or registrar letter. Failure may cancel admission.
