



Annual Report FY 2024. https://hscrc.maryland.gov/pages/commission-meetings.aspx Between 2017 - 20, the **vacancy rates for registered nurses in both Maryland and the U.S.** remained steady at about 8%. In 2021, however, rates rose sharply to 19% in Maryland and 17% nationally, likely reflecting the impact of COVID-19, which both increased demand for health care services and reduced the available workforce. While the national vacancy rate declined slightly to 16% in 2022 and 2023, Maryland's rate remained persistently higher at 18 - 19%. By 2024, national vacancy rates showed a steep drop to 10%, approaching pre-COVID-19 levels. Maryland's rates remained higher than the national average but followed the same downward trend at a slower pace, declining only to 16%.
